The Average Price Contract at CHS helps to take some of the emotion out of making grain marketing decisions, by utilizing a marketing tool that prices an equal volume of bushels each day during the specified pricing period. With this program, you'll specify the number of bushels along with your desired CHS delivery location, and enroll in the program by entering into a forward contract with CHS.

No bushel enrollment minimums. You can price any unpriced bushels at any time for an additional fee\*, if you decide this is no longer the right fit for your marketing plan. All while utilizing the continued support of your experienced CHS grain marketing team.

### Additional details

- When the pricing period ends, the futures price component of the contract price will be the average closing settlement price over the pricing period.
- Set basis separately prior to time of delivery.
- Producer can price any unpriced bushels at any time for an additional fee.\*

### Enrollment period

April 1 - 26, 2024

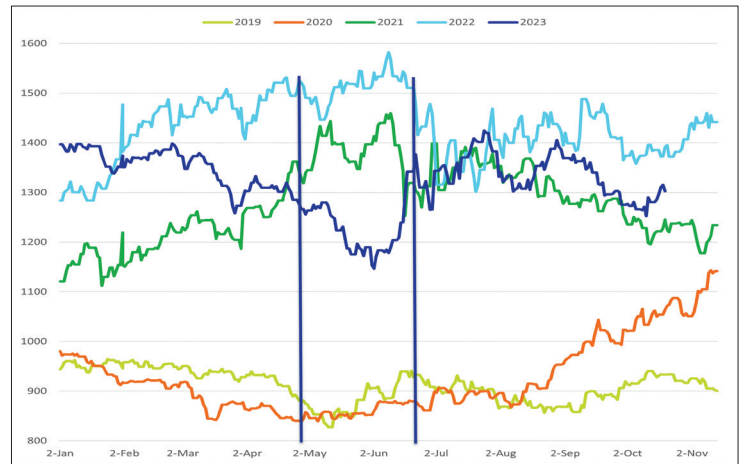

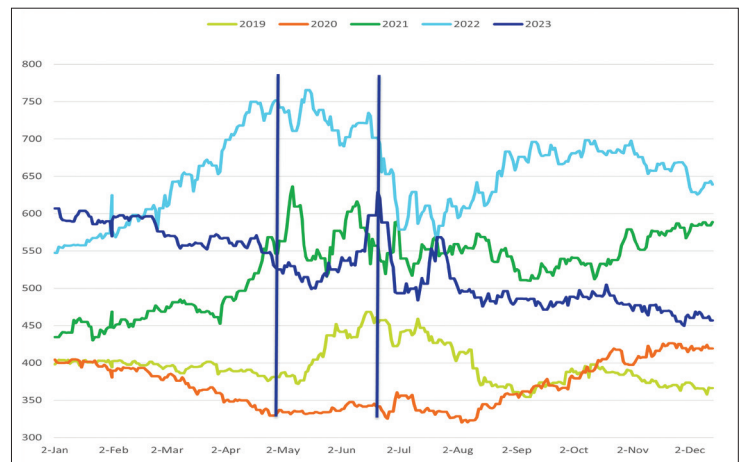

New Crop 2024 Soybeans	SX24	April 29 - June 21, 2024	5 cents/bushel

New Crop 2025 Soybeans	SX25	April 29 - June 21, 2024	12 cents/bushel
